

**ELIGIBILITY
FOR
ADULT DRUG COURT**

The Adult Drug Court program serves as a sentencing alternative for a very specific population. To qualify, potential participants are pre-screened for the following criteria:

1. **Seriously addicted offender** - crime or violation arises from addiction, or addiction seriously impedes ability to function as a responsible adult.
2. **Non-violent offender** - current violation or offense does not involve death or serious bodily injury, a dangerous weapons offense or a sex crime. Prior offenses of violence, may not involve convictions of AGBH or higher (AWIM, MUR etc). Prior weapons convictions may exclude participation, but are subject to review.
3. **Prison and Jail Bound Offenders** - We target offenders who would otherwise be sentenced to jail or prison with SGL from 0 to 17 to and including 12 to 24. Probation/parole violators are acceptable.
4. **Exclusions--** First time offenders (low guidelines) should be referred to the prosecutor's office for consideration in their diversion program(s).
5. **Additional programs--**Funding for Buprenorphine Assisted Treatment for opiate addicted offenders has been suspended until further notice.
